Member at Large, Holly Crombie: Diana and Holly will meet with Epi for the food decision.

Old Business: Davey asked the Board to approve a property committee consisting of Davey and Nancy Jacobs and it was approved. Maggie Brown will also be on the committee.

New Business: We have been approached by members of Shoestring Players to develop a method of sharing property for shows. The Board agreed to do it.

Davey brought up the subject of pre-selling tickets to members for shows. The Board voted that we will not do it in the future. A question was raised about a limit as to how many tickets anyone can buy. The answer is "no". We will ask that, if you are buying for a group of people, you bring only one check, or cash for everyone. The record keeping is a nightmare if we don't do that.

Cyndy Gierada talked about the upcoming Choral concert and that they are having a recording done at the Desert Hills Lutheran Church. Dec. 13 will be a "Mingle and Jingle" in the ballroom. On Dec. 21st the Choral group will be going caroling for shut-ins in QC. Let her know of anyone to contact to see if they want them to stop by.
