

## QUAIL CREEK PERFORMING ARTS GUILD

Minutes of the Board Meeting on March 22, 2022

Board members present: Cyndy Gierada, Davey Jones, Mary Campbell-Jones, Bill Entwistle, Patty Zatkan, Diana Paul, Sydney Ranney

The meeting was called to order at 1:58 by Cyndy Gierada.

Treasurer, Sydney: She reported that we have \$16,568.20 in our account accruing \$3500 in costs for storage and insurance. The Choral group show will bring in a good amount of revenue. She has given Cyndy all of the Expo info.

Publicity, Dodie Prescott: Cyndy reported for Dodie that she continues to provide information for What's Happening and the Quail Creek Crossing.

Secretary, Mary Campbell-Jones: She said the Feb. minutes were approved and posted on the QCPAG web site.

VP Comedy and Drama, Davey Jones: Rumors is moving right along with 456 tickets sold as of that day. He will ask the membership for help in moving and painting the set. He made a motion for approval to get a \$25 gift card for Dianne Thomson for her work on our Poster Board and tickets for Rumors. Sydney seconded and it was passed. Davey also reported that the portable bar he obtained for Rumors ended up being damaged in transport and he needed to buy a new glass top. He asked the board to approve \$69 for the new top. Cyndy made a motion to accept, it was seconded and passed.

Davey also made a proposal that his Murder Mystery show become a part of PAG. The playwright, Davey, would not charge for the script. It will enable us to use mikes and sound equipment so we can open the show to the whole ballroom allowing for more income for PAG. Cyndy made a point that it would be good to give it a go next Feb. and see how it goes. Bill made a motion to accept the proposal and all voted aye.

VP Variety and Music, Bill Entwistle: Bill talked about the upcoming "Quail Creek has Talent" show on August 27<sup>th</sup>. Auditions will be held.

Membership, Patty Zatkan: She reported that we have 68 members and one new resident interested.

Member at Large, Diana Paul: She said we have \$450 in the Rumor's budget for a cast party and she will find someone to host the party.

Cyndy talked about the cast party after the Choral Group show and we have \$150 set aside. The chorus is looking into going to a recording studio in Tucson. Some of the chorus is willing to do some Christmas caroling for shut-ins.

Sydney suggested that we should do an article in The Quail Crossing about how PAG has progressed since our inception in 2003 for the residents to understand our mission.

No old business.

New business: Cyndy said we need a nomination committee to present a slate for the upcoming election of officers. Up for re-election is Pres., Member at Large, VP of Comedy and Drama and we need a Treasurer to replace Sydney since she is moving. Cyndy asked Bill if he would head it.

There was also a discussion again about needing a new web master and someone to take over control of the storage unit inventory.
