Membership, Patty Zatkin: Patty reported that we have a returning member, Maggie Brown. She reported that the Choral Concert was a great success. She thanked Elza Harmon for constructing the rails for the risers.

Member-at-large, Diana Paul: She said the cast parties for "Rumors" and the Choral concert were well attended and came under budget.

Old Business: Bill presented the slate of officers to the membership and pointed out that we still need someone to run for President. He asked the candidates to provide him with a bio to be sent out to the membership before voting. The ballots should be on the web site by May 10 and sent to members for voting. The ballots can be returned to him at his house or by mail.

New Business: Davey talked about a certificate for Valerie Easterly for her commitment as prop coordinator for "Rumors". She did a great job.

Davey asked to be removed as a candidate for VP of Comedy and Drama and said he would run for President.
