The following Board Members actively engaged in the meeting on-line:

**President, Davey Jones:** Visited Chase bank on July 7th with Secretary to change new President and Treasurer as "signers" on PAG bank account.

**Secretary, Mary Campbell-Jones:** Minutes of May 24th meeting have been placed on the PAG website.

**Treasurer, Sandi Hrovatin:** Visited Chase bank to confirm herself as a "signer" on PAG bank account. As of June 30, 2022 bank balance is \$11893.17.

**Publicity, Dodie Prescott:** Currently WH Announcements and QC Crossing articles for the Talent Show. Upcoming will be publicity for the Choral Concert in October and Christmas Show in December.

Each one act will have a separate director, so if you want to try out your directorial skills, and even learn new ones, this opportunity awaits you. The total cast count is 3 men and 5 women. The same set can be used for all three plays, with simple modifications. The plays will be available to read/download in January. Auditions, call backs and final casting will be held the week of February 19.

If you are interested in directing, I can get a script to you in January. Once the directors are set, a rehearsal schedule will be created and the attempt to pull together a crew will swing into action.

**VP Music/Variety, Bill Entwistle:** Bill presented a budget for the "Talent Show" for approval by the Board. Davey seconded the motion and the entire Board approved the budget.

Sales commence on August 1. Cyndy Gierada, Ticket Chair, feels show should sell out in 1 or 2 sale dates.

People requesting audition times has been extremely low, at this time. Hopefully when the article appears in the Crossing, things will pick up. The committee felt it would be easier to make a donation of cash to the food bank rather than collecting goods...hence the \$5 donation of ticket price. The \$40 Miscellaneous Expense was added for any unexpected costs that may arise.
