Minutes of the Board Meeting October 25, 2022

President Davey Jones called the meeting to order at 2:05.

Secretary, Mary Campbell-Jones: The Sept. minutes were approved and posted on the web site.

Treasurer, Sandi Hrovatin: Sandi said we have a bank balance of \$11,923.07.

Membership: Pres. Davey Jones reported for Patty Zatkan that we have 58 members as of that date.

Publicity, Dodie Prescott: She reported that What's Happening will have the information for the first sale of Christmas Show tickets on Oct 31st. The Nov. Crossing will have information about the Christmas show and that our Chorus is planning to go caroling for any shut-ins in QC on Dec. 21rd.

VP Comedy and Drama, Maggie Brown: She has sent out an updated script for "When I'm Gone", one of the 3 One-act plays for the Spring Show. She is looking for directors for each act. Sandi expressed interest.

VP Music and Variety, Bill Entwistle: Bill presented his budget for the Christmas Show. Davey made a motion to accept and it was approved. Bill had the poster for the show which was done by Dianne Thomson and it looks great. Cost is \$82.00. Bill needs members to step up for various duties associated with behind-the-scenes production.

Member at Large, Holly Crombie: She obtained the food for the Choral Show's cast party and reported that there was a lot of food left over. After a discussion, the board determined that we should try to get a realistic head count before we order the food to help cut back on amount and cost. She and Diana Paul have planned the dinner for the Christmas show at a cost of \$37 per meal. Tickets are \$45.

Old Business: Davey reported that Ray Hebert told him the Shoestring Players have approved a partnership with QCPAG to share our property. They already have some of ours.

New Business: The audit was done of the treasurer's account and everything is OK.

Davey also said that the QCLGA (Lady 18 holers) has requested that we donate 2 Christmas Show tickets for their upcoming Charity Event. After a discussion it was decided not to donate and Davey will write a letter of explanation as to why.
