

## QUAIL CREEK PERFORMING ARTS GUILD

Minutes of the Board meeting on April 27, 2022

In attendance: Mary Campbell-Jones, Davey Jones, Diana Paul, Patty Zatkan, Bill Entwistle, Dodie Prescott

The meeting was called to order at 2:02 p.m. by Davey in place of Cyndy Gierada, President.

Secretary, Mary Campbell-Jones: The minutes of the March meeting were approved and are on the web site.

Treasurer, Davey Jones, in for Sydney Ranney: He reported that we have \$17, 576.84 in the bank. Of that amount \$3901 in expenses from "Rumors" has not cleared. In addition, \$3500 is set aside for 2022 expenses of storage units and insurance.

Publicity, Dodie Prescott: Dodie will be putting an article about the upcoming "Quail Creek has Talent" show in the July Crossing

VP Comedy and Drama, Davey Jones: Davey reported about the success of the play "Rumors". 484 tickets were sold for an income of \$9680. Expenses were \$5726.32 leaving a net profit of \$3953.68. Patty asked why the cost of the programs was less than the estimate and that is because we printed them ourselves. We had the show recorded and will send out the link to the cast.

VP Music and Variety, Bill Entwistle: He is working on the script for the Christmas show. For the QC has Talent show he will be putting a group together for auditions on Aug. 1. The show is the 27<sup>th</sup> and Sandy Boyer has offered to help. There was a discussion about having a poster made.

Membership, Patty Zatkan: Patty reported that we have a returning member, Maggie Brown. She reported that the Choral Concert had a great turn out with audience participation.

Member-at-large, Diana Paul: She said the cast parties for "Rumors" and the Choral concert were well attended and came under budget.

Old Business: Bill is the board member that headed up the election committee. Bill was willing to put himself on the ballot for President but it was pointed out that, per the bylaws, he could not run for office as head of the committee. The ballot should be on the web site by May 10 at the latest and sent to members for voting.

New Business: Davey talked about a certificate for Valerie Easterly for her commitment as prop coordinator for "Rumors".

The meeting was adjourned at 2:55. p.m.
