Minutes of the QCPAG General Meeting of April 23, 2019

President Cyndy Gierada: Cyndy called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. and noted that the Board had approved the March minutes and they were posted to the PAG website.

Old Business: The catered picnic was held after the General Meeting today at the Pickleball Ramada at 4:00 p.m. A total of 53 members and guests were in attendance. Cyndy and the new PAG chorus performed.

New Business: Davey reported that the Nominating Committee including Davey, Pam Campbell and Jay Hochstein have a slate to present. The slate is VP Variety and Music, Dodie Prescott and Paul White; Secretary, Sandy Boyer; Membership, Fay Shapiro; Publicity, (no candidate) and Member at Large, #2, Diana Paul. The election will be conducted at the May meeting and the slate will be posted on the PAG website two weeks prior to the election.
